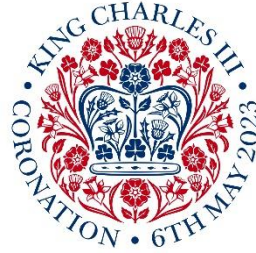

As such, next week (week beginning Monday 1st May), will be set aside for the whole school to learn about King Charles and the coronation of a monarch.

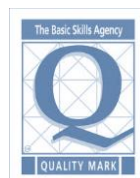
Each year group will focus on a decade of the King's life and we will be planning lots of exciting learning based around that decade.
