Please note that children <u>must</u> have long sleeve tops and trousers for lots of the activities, even if it is a hot day. This is a PGL health and safety requirement and children who do not have long sleeve tops and trousers will not be allowed on certain activities.

The site can be muddy and, during the physical activities, clothes can easily get damaged. As such, we strongly recommend that your child brings their old clothes, rather than buying new clothes specifically for the trip.
