Future Learning at The Discovery School

Here at The Discovery School, we like to prepare children for their future by providing them with a well-rounded technology education, enhanced by extra-curricular clubs.

Our curriculum focuses on computing skills as well as future technology. This looks at the possible technologies which are emerging which may change the way we look at the world.
