



# PTA Welcome Pack

## A WARM WELCOME TO YOUR PTA

We will keep this brief – we know that everyone is busy and there is a lot to do before the start of the school year and before you join our school community!

We just wanted to take a few moments to introduce ourselves and to give you some key information about the PTA (Parent Teacher Association) ahead of the new school year.

### Why does the School have a PTA

Our group is called 'Friends of Discovery School' – or FODS for short. We are a committee of volunteers made up of parents, teachers and staff members, to run our registered charity.

The main function of our PTA is to support the school by raising as much money as we can to enhance, enrich and improve learning experiences for the children. We also provide those 'little extras' that make school memorable, such as including a Christmas pantomime and leavers gifts. The new starters in Year R also receive a small gift at the start of term to help them with their transition into school life.

We also exist to bring the communities of school and home closer together because it makes sense for parents to be involved in the life of their chosen school.

Lastly, we're here for the simple reason that we want to get together socially, meet new people and have fun!

We might sound like an abstract group of people, but we're parents, carers, friends and allies – just like you. Not so long ago, we were new too.

### What does the PTA do?

Over the past few years, we have proudly donated nearly **£70,000** to the school. This has funded the supply of 30 iPads, outdoor play equipment, sound & lighting rigs for the school production and the adventure trail.

This year we reached our target to raise **£10,000** to put towards an exciting new all-weather **MUGA sports pitch** for the children of the school that will be installed around Spring 2023. This will benefit the children by providing them with a suitable place to play sports all year round.

In previous years we have managed to donate £11,000 for 30 iPads and paid for outdoor play equipment too.

As well as this, we pay for a variety of small gifts and activities for the children to enjoy throughout the year – including a Christmas pantomime and leavers gifts.

Our team of volunteers can provide all this by organising a range of fundraising events throughout the year – including school fairs, book sales, raffles, quiz nights and other family events.

## What are the PTA Goals for 2023/2024?

This year we are aiming to raise additional funds for the completion of the all-weather **MUGA sports pitch**.

We will also be working towards supplying a new '**Reading Hut**' for the children to enjoy.

A '**Reading Hut**' will be an essential permanent learning space, providing a private, playful area for the children to develop a passion for literacy and a desire to read for pleasure.

Be part of an important friendly team!
